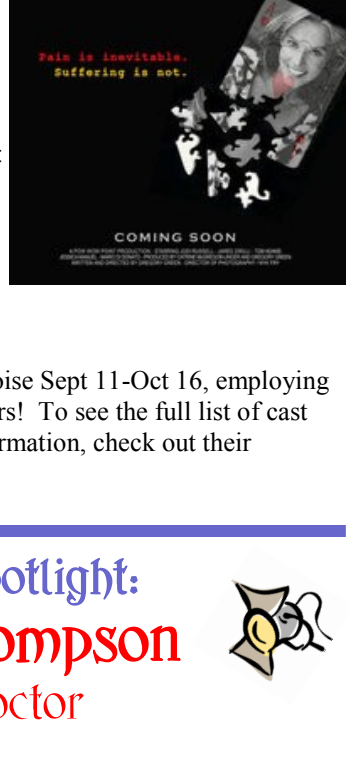

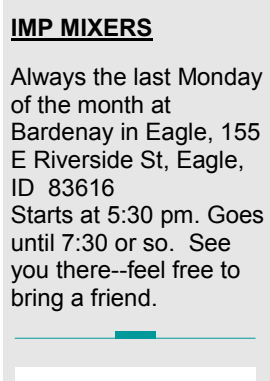

**SCREENWRITING WORKSHOP**  
Nothing is more fundamental to a successful screenplay than sound story structure, yet nothing is more misunderstood. The three-act structure is as old as Aristotle, but the simple rules have been needlessly twisted, misused and confused over the years by those who make their living as storytellers. Lance Thompson demystifies and explains story structure in this enjoyable, instructive, interactive two-day workshop that is guaranteed to improve your ability to write and tell a good story. Students will learn the importance of story, basics of story structure, and how the principles contribute to a memorable screenplay. Students will also participate in class exercises to create stories using what they've learned. Lance Thompson has been a script doctor for movies (*The Two Jakes, The Honeyymooners*), written for television (*Mr. Belvedere*), and conducted screen writing classes for the Scriptwriters Network in Los Angeles and for the Idaho Film Office. His writing and photography have appeared in two dozen magazines and newspapers, including *Air & Space Smithsonian* and *Cowboys & Indians*, as well as the recent book *X Plane Crashes*.
